Fee Information

Due to restrictions imposed on MRI access throughout Australia our MRI scanner does not attract a Medicare rebate. At Envision, your Specialist, GP, Physiotherapist, Podiatrist or other health professional can refer you directly for an MRI at an affordable price. You would need a specialist's referral to receive a Medicare rebate on most other scanners.

There are further advantages for you:

1. You will be able to get a scan quickly and receive any required treatment much sooner.
2. MRI is often superior to other imaging modalities meaning you can potentially avoid having other unnecessary scans or tests.

Having your MRI scan at Envision will likely save you time and money, whilst giving you an accurate diagnosis on the most comfortable, high quality MRI Scanner in Perth.



Patient Information

You have been referred to Envision to have an MRI (Magnetic Resonance Imaging) Scan. We are proud to inform you that this is currently WA's least claustrophobic scanner. The wide magnet bore (the part you lie in) is also the shortest in Perth, making it a more comfortable experience for you, compared with other MRI scanners. Most importantly, the excellent image quality allows for accurate diagnosis by our specialist MRI Radiologists.

Our aim is to make this experience as pleasant as possible for you. We encourage you to bring along a CD of your favourite music for you to listen to during your scan (alternatively we can provide a selection of music for you.)

The MRI scanner will make various tapping or buzzing noises as part of the normal process of acquiring your images. A scan of a single region generally takes between 15 - 25 minutes, though some more complex studies can take a little longer.

MRI does not use ionizing radiation like X-rays or CT scanning. The MRI Scanner is however, a very powerful magnet so some patients with certain implants or metallic/electronic devices cannot have an MRI scan. 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Most metal screws, clips & rods used in surgery are safe to be scanned as they are made of titanium (non-magnetic), but we will ask you about these on the day of your scan. Similarly cardiac (coronary) stents and valves are considered safe to be scanned.
