**CAMBRIDGE STREET (MCCOURT STREET TO STATION STREET)
NOTIFICATION OF ROADWORKS – NOVEMBER 2021**

The Town thanks you for your patience whilst we get this project underway. There was a slight delay to the commencement date as additional works are included to further improve Cambridge Street. These works will now include removal of a tram passing lane between Station Street and Joseph Street heading towards the city. And resurfacing the outside lane heading towards the coast. This will mean the works will take longer than initially anticipated running from the start of November until 20 December 2021.

We would like to keep you up to date on traffic control throughout the project. For now the following is planned:

- McCourt Street to Station Street 1 November to 23 November – Traffic flow reduced to one lane each both sides;
- McCourt Street to Station Street 23 November to 7 December – Traffic flow at one lane each on the north side of Cambridge Street; and
- Joseph Street to Station Street 7 December to 20 December – Traffic flow at one lane each on the south side of Cambridge Street.

As the fencing must remain throughout the works for your safety, there is a "No Stopping" restriction on both sides of Cambridge Street. We ask you do not park your car on the verge or road near the works because it is likely to be damaged by the works – side roads and parking in your property is fine.

Temporary road closures will be signed during the course of the works to facilitate the safety of pedestrians, motorists and road workers. It is inevitable that work of this nature will cause some inconvenience and every attempt will be made to keep this to a minimum. We seek your understanding during these works and extend thanks in anticipation of your co-operation as we make the Town's roads better.
